Helmets Required to Participate

Freestyle Terrain may contain jumps, hits, ramps, banks, fun boxes, jibs, rails, half pipes, quarter pipes, snowcross, bump terrain and other constructed or natural terrain features.

Prior to using Freestyle Terrain, you are responsible for familiarizing yourself with Freestyle Terrain and obeying all instructions, warnings and signs. Freestyle skills require maintaining control on the ground and in the air.

TERRAIN PARKS ARE NOT NORMAL TRAILS. All users are required to follow Basic Terrain Park Etiquette: The flow of a terrain park is much different than other trails. Whereas, skiers and riders on an ordinary trail are free to continue down hill so long as they yield to skiers and riders downhill of them, **in a terrain park, skiers and riders must yield before and after each park feature, regardless of their intentions to use (or not use) that feature.**

Skiers and riders stopped on the side of the park are rarely stopped to rest as they might be on a normal trail. Instead, they are waiting for the approach and landing of the next feature to clear before “dropping in”. If you see someone waiting above a feature or on the side of the trail, they are likely waiting for it to clear. **You must ask if you may continue or you must yield to them before continuing on down the trail.** This is usually referred to as calling your drop in. Stop and ask – even if you are not using the hit or feature so as to keep the terrain park safe and enjoyable for all.

Remember Smart Style

Look before you leap. You are responsible for inspecting Freestyle Terrain before initial use and throughout the day. The features vary in size and change constantly due to snow conditions, weather, usage, grooming and time of day. Do not jump blindly. Use a spotter when necessary.

Easy Style It. Always ride or ski in control and within your ability level. Do not attempt Freestyle Terrain unless you have sufficient ability and experience to do so safely. You control the degree of difficulty you will encounter in Freestyle Terrain, both on the ground and in the air.

Respect Gets Respect. Respect Freestyle Terrain and others. Only one person on a feature at a time. Wait your turn and call your start. Always clear the landing area quickly. Respect all signs and do not enter Freestyle Terrain or use features when closed.

Use of Freestyle Terrain exposes you to the risk of serious injury or death. **Inverted aerials are prohibited.**

Assumption of Risk Agreement:

I am aware the snowboarding and skiing involve potential risk of serious injury including death. Terrain park activities and airborne maneuvers may greatly increase that risk. Becoming inverted during an aerial maneuver, whether intentional or accidental, substantially increases the risk of serious injury and therefore inverted maneuvers are prohibited. I freely accept and fully assume all risks, dangers and

hazards associated with the use of the Freestyle Terrain park and the possibility of loss, personal injury or death resulting there from. Violation of park rules and guidelines will result in loss of privileges to use the park.

Hold Harmless Agreement:

I further agree to Hold Harmless and Indemnify Recreation Management Corporation, Ski Big Bear and Masthope Mountain Community Property Owners Association from any and all liability for death and or personal injury, medical or other expense or property damage to others or myself resulting in any way from my use of the ski area premises, even if I contend that such injuries are the result of negligence or any other improper conduct on the part of the releases.

I further agree that (1) any claim which I may at any time bring for any reason against Recreation Management Corporation, Ski Big Bear and Masthope Mountain Community Property Owners Association, its employees and agents, shall be submitted to the jurisdiction of the State or Federal Courts of the State of Pennsylvania and no claims or actions shall be brought in any other jurisdictions, and (2) any claim shall be governed by the laws of Pennsylvania.
